Delmar Eugene Lindahl, age 90, of Rensselaer, Indiana, formerly of Roselawn, passed away on Friday, April 3, 2026, in Lafayette, Indiana. He was born on October 12, 1935, in Fair Oaks, Indiana, to Charles and Violet (Roadruck) Lindahl, who preceded him in death.

Delmar graduated from Mt. Ayr High School with the Class of 1953. He married the love of his life, Barbara Jean Carlson, on April 14, 1956, in Thayer, Indiana. She preceded him in death on April 3, 2008, exactly 18 years prior.

Delmar worked in route sales and distribution for Archway Cookies and Bozeman Oil and previously delivered milk for Pleasant View Dairy.
