



## Leland Duane Halleck

June 16, 1927 - June 5, 2026

Leland Duane Halleck, age 98, formerly of Fair Oaks, Indiana, passed away peacefully on Friday, June 5, 2026, at Victorian Village in Homer Glen, Illinois. Born on June 16, 1927, in Hammond, Indiana, Leland was the son of Leland Bob Halleck and Eva Lena (Morganegg) Halleck Long.

Leland graduated from the United States Naval Academy in Annapolis, Maryland, and proudly served his country in the United States Air Force. He later married Anna Jane Wood, and together they shared many years of marriage until her passing on February 4, 2006. Throughout their lives together, they made their homes in McMurray, Pennsylvania; Dolton, Illinois; Hammond, Indiana; and Anderson, South Carolina, where they resided for 34 years.

A dedicated professional, Leland spent more than 30 years with Nalco Chemical Company, serving as a National Sales Account Manager. Outside of his career, he enjoyed playing bridge and achieved the distinguished rank of Life Master. Following Anna's passing, he shared many years of companionship with Nancy Jeralom, who was also his bridge partner for more than 20 years. Leland also found great fulfillment in serving others through the Meals on Wheels program, volunteering for more than 14 years and delivering meals twice daily to those in need.
